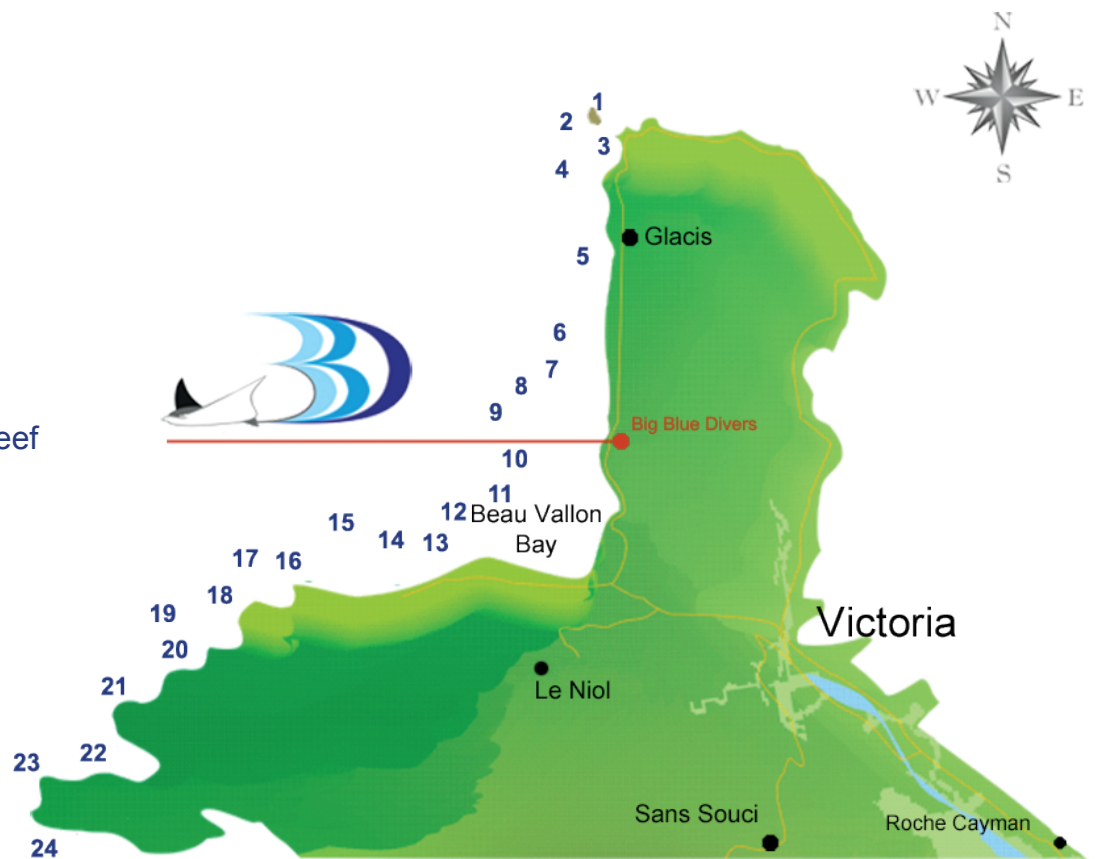


Big Blue Divers – Dive Sites & Maps

We organize dives to the dive sites with short distance boat trips on a daily basis, the travel time to these sites usually takes no longer than 15 minutes. The dive sites with long distance boat trips around Mahe are visited several times per week, under normal circumstances the travel time to these dive sites takes 20 to 40 minutes. The dive sites around the islands Praslin, La Digue and Silhouette are usually visited during our full-day trips.

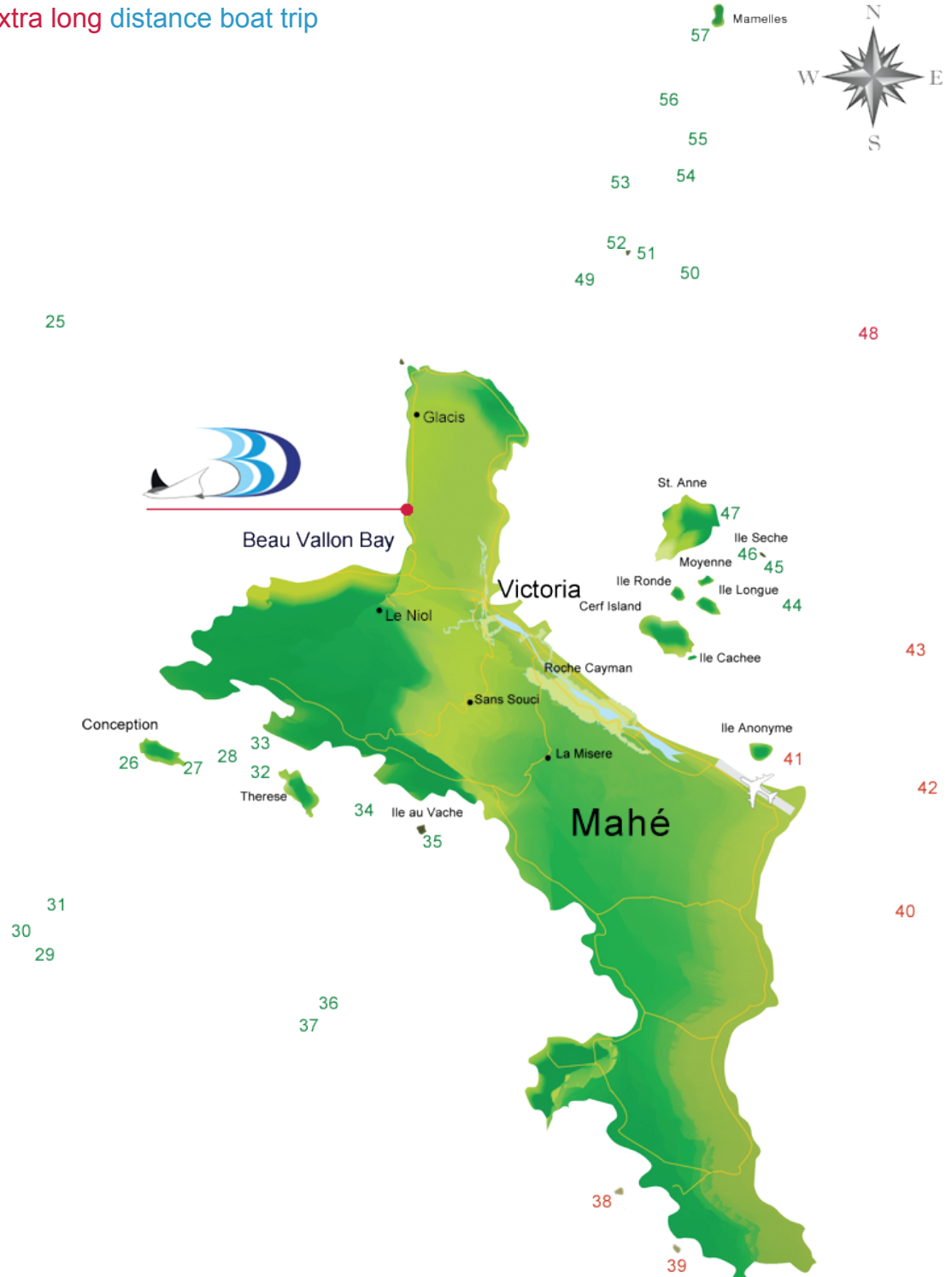

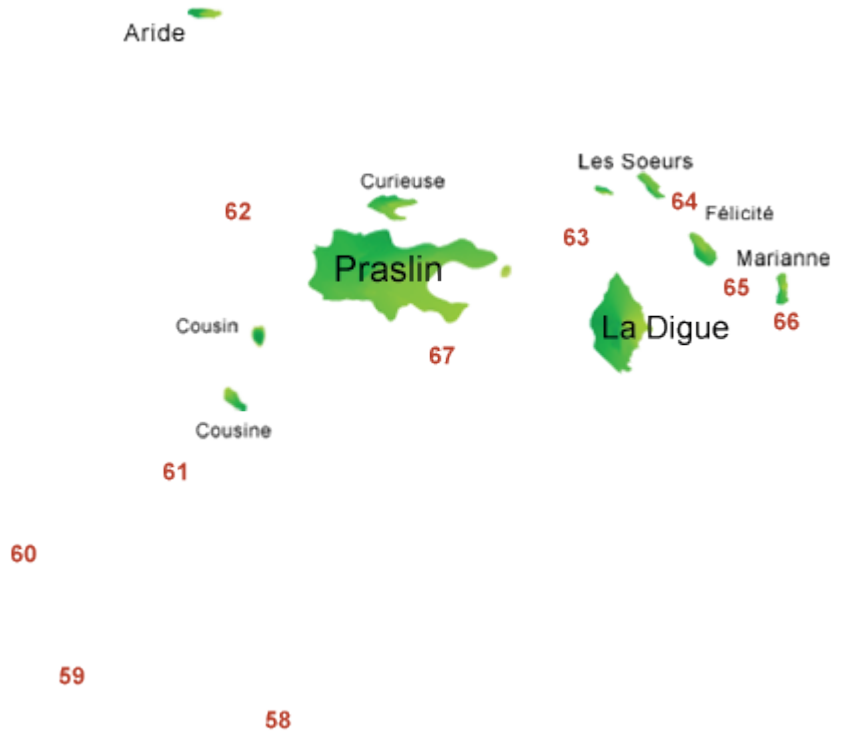

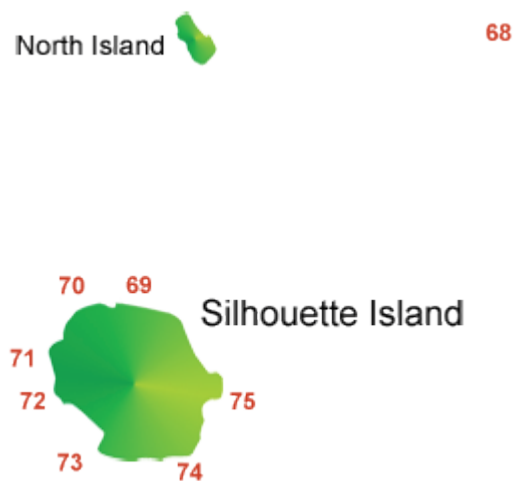
